1. Acceptance of Terms

By signing this document and taking part in any session, event, or activity delivered by XX Parkour, the participant—or the parent/legal guardian of a participant under 18—confirms that they have read, understood, and accepted the terms outlined below.

2. Behaviour Expectations

Participants and/or their parents or carers agree to follow the behavioural guidelines published on our website. Failure to meet these expectations may result in suspension or removal from future activities, at the discretion of XX Parkour.

3. Health Information and Consent

XX Parkour and its staff have a duty to notify parents or guardians in the event of an injury or accident.

Responsibility for seeking any further medical advice or treatment rests with the parent or guardian.

If there are any updates to the participant's health, injuries, or personal circumstances, written notification must be given to XX Parkour before the next session attended.

In the case of a medical emergency where it is not possible to obtain prior consent, the undersigned authorises XX Parkour and its staff to arrange and approve any necessary medical treatment, including anaesthesia or surgery, as determined by qualified medical professionals. The undersigned agrees not to hold XX Parkour or its staff liable for reasonable actions taken in good faith while acting in loco parentis.

4. Liability and Responsibility

The undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold harmless XX Parkour, its representatives and employees against any claims, losses, damages, or costs resulting from:

The actions or behaviour of the participant; or

The participant's failure to follow reasonable instructions or safety procedures set by XX Parkour

This does not apply where such issues arise directly due to the negligence of XX Parkour or its staff.

XX Parkour is not responsible for any loss or damage to personal belongings. It also reserves the right to refuse or discontinue a participant's involvement if their behaviour or circumstances are considered unsafe or unsuitable.

5. Use of Images and Data Protection

The undersigned understands and agrees that photographs, videos, or audio recordings may be taken during sessions and used for promotional, educational, or publicity purposes, including on websites, social media, and in publications. Advance notice will be given where possible, and participants will have the option to opt out.

Personal information supplied to XX Parkour may be stored securely in an electronic system accessible only by authorised personnel. All data will be managed in line with applicable data protection laws.

It is your responsibility or the responsibility of the parent or guardian to inform us if they do not wish for their child to be photographed or recorded.
